Dr. Robert W. Malone	Critic of mRNA vaccines; has raised concerns about their safety and efficacy.	Less vocal; no prominent public stance identified.
Dr. Martin Kulldorff	Supports for high-risk, opposes mandates for low-risk, especially children.	Findings suggest they may reduce mortality more effectively in some groups.
Dr. Cody Meissner	Cautious about use in children due to myocarditis concerns.	No specific public stance identified.
Dr. Retsef Levi	Strongly critical; called for immediate suspension citing safety concerns.	No specific public stance identified.

### **Vaccines in General**

Expresses concerns about safety/regulation; advocates transparency.

Supports targeted vaccination strategies where benefits outweigh risks.

Generally supportive; emphasizes evidence-based recommendations.

Advocates reassessment of safety data; highlights risks.

Focus on nutrition and mental health; no public stance on vaccines.
